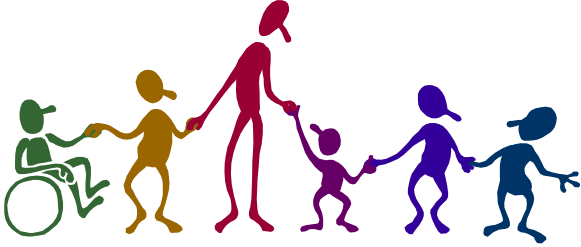


**Our Mission**

Our goal at the EHCDC is to foster healthy relationships and developmental growth. Early intervention is one way we help accomplish this goal. We do this through individual observations, an initial screening, and routine assessments.



We believe children learn best through play and exploration in a stimulating yet safe environment consisting of age-appropriate activities with loving, nurturing teachers to guide them. We strive to create a relaxed comfortable environment with the least amount of restrictions that promotes tolerance and acceptance of each individual's differences and celebrates our similarities in a non-judgmental atmosphere. We believe that all children are unique and special, and should be treated with respect and fairness.

Our Program consists of a curriculum that addresses the social-emotional, cognitive and physical development of the child.
