Esplanade House, a department of Community Action Agency of Butte County, Inc., (CAA) provides housing and supportive services for homeless families with children. CAA is a non-profit organization providing multiple services to low-income residents throughout Butte County since 1967.

Admission

To receive services at the Esplanade House Outpatient Program, you must:

- Be a resident of the Community Action Agency of Butte County, Inc., Esplanade House.
- Be over the age of 18 years old.
- Have an identified need for Substance Abuse Treatment.
- Have at least thirty days of continuous recovery.



Philosophy

Substance Abuse Counselors work in conjunction with the Esplanade House Supportive Housing Program case managers and staff.

This team approach in providing service to the whole family, addresses issues and problems that arise in recovery.

Family case management, group and individual counseling, classes and workshops are incorporated into a comprehensive program for a period of up to two (2) years.

Our program approach is a strength based model. We affirm and support individualized care and strongly encourage you to build a recovery support system within the 12-step community or other related support systems.

Our staff is encouraging and optimistic about your future. If you are ready to change the direction of your life, we are here to help.
